

Instructions for the letter of commitment

The MANUNET-III proposal with Dutch applicants requesting funding from M2i must be accompanied by a letter of commitment from the industrial applicants.

The letter needs to be written:

- In English
- On company stationary
- Addressed to the Dutch project leader:
<name + title>
<University>
<Postal address>

Checklist:

Make sure that the letter:

- Clearly explains the importance of the research subject for the company and the importance of transnational cooperation;
- Provides compelling arguments on the fit within the thematic scope of M-ERA.NET-2, as well as within the scope of [High Tech Materials - HTM Roadmap](#);
- Details the involvement of the company in the project;
- Shows the way the company plans to use the results of the research;
- States the contribution of the company in terms of minimum cash support for the whole duration of the project, as well as the contribution to the project management costs (if applicable), separately from the project budget).
- Is undersigned by a person legally authorized to commit budgets on behalf of the company/department.
